## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to requiring certain school districts to allow students
- 3 who participate in Special Olympics to earn a letter on that basis.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 33, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 33.093 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 33.093. RECOGNITION OF PARTICIPATION IN SPECIAL
- 8 OLYMPICS. If a school district allows high school students to earn
- 9 <u>a letter for academic, athletic, or extracurricular achievements,</u>
- 10 the district must allow high school students in the district to earn
- 11 <u>a letter on the basis of a student's participation in a Special</u>
- 12 Olympics event.
- SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 14 school year.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
