7 Sec. 26.011. COMPLAINTS. (a) The board of trustees of each

8 school district shall adopt a grievance procedure under which the

9 board shall address each complaint that the board receives

10 concerning violation of a right guaranteed by this chapter.

11 (b) The board of trustees of a school district is not

12 required by Subsection (a) or Section 11.1511(b)(13) to address a

complaint that the board receives concerning a student's

participation in an extracurricular activity that does not involve

15 a violation of a right guaranteed by this chapter. This subsection

16 does not affect a claim brought by a parent under the Individuals

17 with Disabilities Education Act (20 U.S.C. Section 1400 et seq.) or

18 <u>a successor federal statute addressing special education services</u>

19 for a child with a disability.

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
