Section 15.022(a), Election Code, is amended to 4 5 read as follows: 6 (a) The registrar shall make the appropriate corrections in the registration records, including, if necessary, deleting a 7 voter's name from the suspense list: 8 9 (1) after receipt of a notice of a change in registration information under Section 15.021; 10 11 (2) after receipt of a voter's reply to a notice of 12 investigation given under Section 16.033; 13 [after receipt of any affidavits executed (3) 14 Section 63.006, following an election; 15 [(4)] after receipt of a voter's statement of residence executed under Section 63.0011; 16 (4) [(5)] before the effective date of the abolishment 17 of a county election precinct or a change in its boundary; 18 (5) [(6)] after receipt of United States Postal 19 20 Service information indicating an address reclassification; 21 (6) [(7)] after receipt of a voter's response under 22 Section 15.053; or (7) [(8)] after receipt of a registration application 23 or change of address under Chapter 20. 24

SECTION 2. Section 63.006, Election Code, is amended to 1 read as follows: 2 Sec. 63.006. VOTER [WITH REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION] WHO IS NOT 3 ON LIST. (a) A voter who, when offering to vote, presents the 4 5 documentation required under Section 63.001(b) but whose name is not on the precinct list of registered voters <u>may</u> [shall] be 6 accepted for provisional voting only under Section 63.011 [if the 7 8 voter also presents a voter registration certificate indicating that the voter is currently registered: 9 10 [(1) in the precinct in which the voter is offering to vote; or 11 [(2) in a different precinct in the same county as the 12 precinct in which the voter is offering to vote and the voter 13 14 executes an affidavit stating that the voter: 15 $[(\Lambda)$ is a resident of the precinct in which the voter is offering to vote or is otherwise entitled by law to vote in 16 17 that precinct; [(B) was a resident of the precinct in which the 18 voter is offering to vote at the time the information on the voter's 19 residence address was last provided to the voter registrar; 20 [(C) did not deliberately provide false 21 information to secure registration in a precinct in which the voter 22 does not reside; and 23 24 [(D) is voting only once in the election]. 25 For a [After the] voter to whom this section applies [is (b) accepted], an election officer shall attempt to verify with the 26 voter registrar that the voter is a registered voter [+ 27

Section 63.011(a), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 A person to whom Section 63.001(g) or 63.006 [63.009] 7 (a) 8 applies may cast a provisional ballot if the person executes an affidavit stating that the person: 9 is a registered voter in the precinct in which the 10 (1)person seeks to vote; and 11 is eligible to vote in the election. 12 (2) SECTION 4. Section 66.0241, Election Code, is amended to 13 14 read as follows: 15 Sec. 66.0241. CONTENTS OF ENVELOPE NO. 4. Envelope no. 4 16 must contain: 17 (1) the precinct list of registered voters; the registration correction list; 18 (2) any statements of residence executed under Section 19 (3) 63.0011; and 20 any affidavits executed under Section [63.006 or] 21 (4) 22 63.011. SECTION 5. Section 63.009, Election Code, is repealed. 23 24 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
