- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 404, Labor Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 404.1525 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 404.1525. LAW ENFORCEMENT LIAISON. (a) In this
- 8 section, "law enforcement officer" means a person who is a sworn
- 9 peace officer under Article 2.12, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 10 (b) The public counsel shall designate an employee of the
- 11 office to act as law enforcement liaison.
- 12 <u>(c)</u> The law enforcement liaison shall assist an injured law
- 13 enforcement officer and, if applicable, the ombudsman assigned to
- 14 the law enforcement officer's case, during a workers' compensation
- 15 administrative dispute resolution process.
- 16 (d) The law enforcement liaison:
- 17 (1) must meet the qualifications for designation as an
- 18 ombudsman under this subchapter; and
- 19 (2) is subject to the training and education
- 20 requirements for an ombudsman under this subchapter.
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 404.153, Labor Code, is amended by
- 22 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 23 (a-1) An employer that commissions law enforcement officers
- 24 shall notify the officers of the law enforcement liaison in the

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- 1 manner prescribed by the office. In this subsection, "law
- 2 <u>enforcement officer" means a person who is a sworn peace officer</u>
- 3 <u>under Article 2.12</u>, Code of Criminal Procedure.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
