## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the prizes awarded in certain pull-tab bingo games.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2001.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by adding Subdivision (6-a) to read as follows:
- 6 (6-a) "Carryover pull-tab bingo" means a form of
- 7 pull-tab bingo that is played in successive event pull-tab bingo
- 8 deals of the same form number and in which a portion of the bingo
- 9 prize awarded to the winner of the event prize for each deal is paid
- 10 into a jackpot prize, the winner of the event prize for each deal
- 11 has the opportunity to win the jackpot prize, and the play continues
- 12 until the jackpot prize is awarded.
- SECTION 2. Section 2001.420, Occupations Code, is amended
- 14 by amending Subsections (a) and (b) and adding Subsection (d) to
- 15 read as follows:
- 16 (a) Except for a jackpot prize awarded in a carryover
- 17 pull-tab bingo game, a [A] bingo prize may not have a value of more
- 18 than \$750 for a single game.
- 19 (b) A person may not offer or award on a single bingo
- 20 occasion prizes with an aggregate value of more than \$2,500 for all
- 21 bingo games other than:
- 22 (1) pull-tab bingo, including carryover pull-tab
- 23 bingo; or
- 24 (2) bingo games that award individual prizes of \$50 or

- 1 less.
- 2 (d) A jackpot prize awarded in a carryover pull-tab bingo
- 3 game may not have a value of more than \$10,000.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
