## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 7801, Special District
6	Local Laws Code, is amended by adding Section 7801.003 to read as
7	follows:
8	Sec. 7801.003. DISSOLUTION OF DISTRICT. (a) Not later than
9	18 months after the next regularly scheduled election of directors
10	under Section 7801.051, the Commissioners Courts of Dallas and
11	Kaufman Counties may dissolve the district if:
12	(1) at that election, the appropriate number of
13	directors under Section 7801.051(c) are not elected; or
14	(2) the directors elected at that election fail to
15	attend 50 percent of the board meetings scheduled during the 12
16	months following that election.
17	(b) To dissolve the district under Subsection (a), the
18	Commissioners Courts of Dallas County and Kaufman County each must
19	issue an order dissolving the district. The orders must provide for
20	the:
21	(1) sale or transfer of the district's assets and

the district until all money has been disposed of and all district

(2) administration of property, assets, and debts of

- 1 debts have been paid or settled; and
- 2 <u>(3) continued provision of the district's services</u>
- 3 without interruption to the extent the district has been providing
- 4 services.
- 5 (c) The dissolution of the district and the sale or transfer
- 6 of the district's assets and liabilities may not:
- 7 (1) violate a trust indenture or bond resolution
- 8 relating to the outstanding bonds of the district; or
- 9 (2) diminish or impair the rights of the holders of
- 10 outstanding bonds, warrants, or other obligations of the district.
- 11 (d) This section expires January 1, 2020.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
