- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 86.014(a), Election Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) A copy of an application for a ballot to be voted by mail
- 7 is not available for public inspection, except to the voter seeking
- 8 to verify that the information pertaining to the voter is accurate,
- 9 until the first business day after the election day of the latest
- 10 occurring election for which the application is submitted. An
- 11 application submitted under Section 86.0015 is not available for
- 12 public inspection before the first business day after the latest
- 13 occurring election held by the authority to which the application
- 14 was submitted in the calendar year for which the application was
- 15 submitted.
- SECTION 2. Section 87.121(f), Election Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (f) Information on the roster for a person to whom an early
- 19 voting mail ballot has been sent is not available for public
- 20 inspection, except to the voter seeking to verify that the
- 21 information pertaining to the voter is accurate, until the first
- 22 business day after the election day of the latest occurring
- 23 election for which the application is submitted.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
