(a) The comptroller may not deposit to the credit of the general revenue 8

- 9 fund money received from the federal government or accrued interest or other earnings on money received from the federal government. 10 This subsection prevails over other general law that provides for 11 money received from the federal government, or earnings on money 12 received from the federal government, to be deposited to the credit 13 of the general revenue fund or to the credit of an account in the 14 general revenue fund. The comptroller shall account for and 15 16 administer federal money separately from money in the general

  20 (b) The comptroller may establish a special fund in the
