| 6 | SECTION 1. Section 25.0022, Government Code, is amended by |
| 7 | amending Subsections (m), (o), and (p) and adding Subsection (o-1) |
| 8 | to read as follows: |
| 9 | (m) The presiding judge shall certify to the county judge in |
| 10 | the county in which the assigned judge served: |
| 11 | (1) the expenses approved under Subsection (1); [and] |
| 12 | (2) a determination of the assigned judge's salary <u>;</u> |
| 13 | and |
| 14 | (3) if applicable, a determination of the amounts to |
| 15 | be apportioned to a party or between two or more parties to a |
| 16 | probate proceeding as prescribed under Subsection (o-1), together |
| 17 | with the contact information of the party or parties. |
| 18 | (o) The county in which the assigned judge served: |
| 19 | (1) shall pay out of the general fund of the county: |
| 20 | $\underline{\text{(A)}}[\frac{\text{(1)}}{\text{)}}]$ expenses certified under Subsection (m) |
| 21 | to the assigned judge; and |
| 22 | $\underline{\text{(B)}}[\frac{\text{(2)}}{\text{)}}$ the salary certified under Subsection |
| 23 | (m) to the county in which the assigned judge serves, or, if the |

assigned judge is a former or retired judge, to the assigned judge $\underline{\boldsymbol{\cdot}}$

- 2 (2) may seek reimbursement from one or more parties to
- 3 a probate proceeding of the amounts apportioned to a party or
- 4 between the parties as prescribed under Subsection (o-1).
- 5 (o-1) If a party to a probate proceeding files a motion for
- 6 the assignment of a statutory probate court judge to hear a
- 7 contested matter in the proceeding under Section 32.003, Estates
- 8 Code, and the motion is granted, the party shall reimburse the
- 9 county for the compensation and expenses paid by the county under
- 10 Subsections (o) and (p). If more than one party to a proceeding
- 11 files a motion for the assignment of a statutory probate court judge
- 12 under Section 32.003, Estates Code, the statutory probate court
- 13 judge shall:
- 14 (1) prescribe the amounts or manner by which the
- 15 judge's compensation and expenses are to be equitably apportioned
- 16 between those parties for purposes of reimbursement under this
- 17 section; and
- 18 (2) provide the amounts or manner of apportionment to
- 19 the presiding judge.
- 20 (p) In addition to all compensation and expenses authorized
- 21 by this section and other law, a judge who is assigned to a court
- 22 outside the county of the judge's residence is entitled to receive
- 23 \$25 for each day or fraction of a day served. Subject to Subsection
- 24 (o-1), the $[\frac{The}{T}]$ county in which the judge served shall pay the
- 25 additional compensation from the county's general fund on
- 26 certification by the presiding judge.
- 27 SECTION 2. Section 25.0022, Government Code, as amended by

- 1 this Act, applies only to a motion for the assignment of a statutory
- 2 probate court judge under Section 32.003, Estates Code, that is
- 3 filed on or after the effective date of this Act. A motion filed
- 4 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 5 effect on the date the motion was filed, and the former law is
- 6 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
