- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 31, Penal Code, is amended by adding
- 5 Section 31.19 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 31.19. MAIL THEFT. (a) In this section, "mail" means
- 7 <u>a letter</u>, postal card, package, bag, or other sealed article sent
- 8 through a common carrier and addressed to a person other than the
- 9 sender.
- 10 (b) A person commits an offense if, without the effective
- 11 consent of the applicable addressee and with the intent to deprive
- 12 that addressee of the mail, the person appropriates pieces of mail
- 13 that, in the aggregate, are addressed to at least three persons
- 14 other than the actor.
- 15 <u>(c)</u> An offense under this section is:
- 16 (1) a state jail felony if 10 or fewer pieces of mail
- 17 are appropriated;
- 18 (2) a felony of the third degree if more than 10 but
- 19 fewer than 50 pieces of mail are appropriated; or
- 20 (3) a felony of the second degree if 50 or more pieces
- 21 of mail are appropriated.
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
