8	Sec. 287.001. DISCHARGE OF FIREARM PROHIBITED. (a) In this
9	section, "firearm" has the meaning assigned by Section 62.014.
10	(b) This section applies only to the segment of the Canadiar
11	River extending from the intersection of United States Highways 287
12	and 87 and the Canadian River to:
13	(1) a point 1.2 miles west of the intersection, marked
14	by a structure serving as a railroad trestle; and
15	(2) a point 1.5 miles east of the intersection, where
16	the Canadian River enters the Lake Meredith National Recreational
17	Area.
18	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a person may not
19	discharge a firearm or shoot an arrow from any kind of bow if the
20	person is located in or on the bed or bank of the portion of the
21	Canadian River to which this chapter applies at the time the firearm
