- 5 SECTION 1. Title 7, Parks and Wildlife Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Chapter 287 to read as follows:

7 CHAPTER 287. POTTER COUNTY

- 8 Sec. 287.001. DISCHARGE OF FIREARM PROHIBITED. (a) In this
- 9 section, "firearm" has the meaning assigned by Section 62.014.
- 10 (b) This section applies only to the segment of the Canadian
- 11 River extending from the intersection of United States Highways 287
- 12 and 87 and the Canadian River to:
- 13 (1) a point 1.2 miles west of the intersection, marked
- 14 by a structure serving as a railroad trestle; and
- 15 (2) a point 1.5 miles east of the intersection, where
- 16 the Canadian River enters the Lake Meredith National Recreational
- 17 Area.

- (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), a person may not
- 19 <u>discharge a firearm or shoot an arrow from any kind of bow if the</u>
- 20 person is located in or on the bed or bank of the portion of the
- 21 Canadian River to which this chapter applies at the time the firearm
- 22 is discharged or the arrow is shot from the bow.
- 23 (d) This section does not apply to:
- 24 (1) an individual acting in the scope of the

- 1 individual's duties as a peace officer or department employee; or
- 2 (2) the discharge of a shotgun loaded with ammunition
- 3 that releases only shot when discharged.
- 4 (e) This section does not limit the ability of a license
- 5 holder to carry a concealed handgun under the authority of
- 6 Subchapter H, Chapter 411, Government Code.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
