Section 92.019, Property Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a) and (e) and adding Subsection (a-1) to 6 read as follows: 7 A late fee under this section may include: 8 (a) 9 (1) an initial fee; and (2) a daily fee for each day, not to exceed 15 days, 10 after the date the rent was originally due that the rent continues 11 to remain unpaid. 12 (a-1) A landlord may not charge a tenant a late fee for 13 failing to pay rent unless: 14 (1) notice of the fee is included in a written lease; 15 16 (2) the initial fee does not exceed eight percent of one month's rent and each subsequent daily fee does not exceed one 17 percent of one month's [is a reasonable estimate of uncertain 18 damages to the landlord that are incapable of precise calculation 19 20 and result from late payment of] rent; and 21 (3) the rent has remained unpaid one full day after the 22 date the rent was originally due. (e) This section relates only to a fee, charge, or other sum 23 of money required to be paid under the lease if rent is not paid as 24

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1 provided by Subsection (a-1)(3) [(a)(3)], and does not affect the 2 landlord's right to terminate the lease or take other action 3 permitted by the lease or other law. Payment of the fee, charge, or 4 other sum of money by a tenant does not waive the right or remedies 5 provided by this section.

6 SECTION 2. Section 92.019(b), Property Code, is repealed.

7 SECTION 3. Section 92.019, Property Code, as amended by 8 this Act, applies only to a lease entered into or renewed on or 9 after the effective date of this Act. A lease entered into or 10 renewed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law 11 as it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 12 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.

13 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.

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
