A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the prescribing and ordering of Schedule II controlled

3 substances by certain advanced practice registered nurses and

4 physician assistants.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 562, Occupations Code, is

7 amended by adding Section 562.017 to read as follows:

8 Sec. 562.017. CERTAIN PRESCRIPTIONS FOR CONTROLLED

9 SUBSTANCES. A pharmacist practicing in a Class A pharmacy may

10 <u>dispense</u> a controlled substance listed in Schedule II as

11 <u>established</u> by the commissioner of state health services under

12 Chapter 481, Health and Safety Code, that is prescribed by an

13 <u>advanced practice registered nurse or physician assistant to whom a</u>

14 physician has delegated prescribing and ordering authority under

15 Section 157.0511(b-1). The prescriber shall clearly note in the

16 prescription records that the controlled substance listed in

17 Schedule II is prescribed as part of the care provided in a hospital

18 <u>facility-based practice under Section 157.0511(b-1)(1) or as part</u>

19 of a plan of care under Section 157.0511(b-1)(2).

20 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

24 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
