A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to a notification requirement if a public school,
- 3 including an open-enrollment charter school, does not have a nurse,
- 4 school counselor, or librarian assigned to the school during all
- 5 instructional hours.
- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 25, Education Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 25.097 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 25.097. PARENTAL NOTIFICATION CONCERNING NURSES,
- 10 SCHOOL COUNSELORS, AND LIBRARIANS. (a) In this section:
- 11 <u>(1) "Librarian" means a person certified as a</u>
- 12 <u>librarian under Subchapter B, Chapter 21.</u>
- 13 (2) "Nurse" means a person licensed under Chapter 301,
- 14 Occupations Code.
- 15 (3) "School counselor" means a person certified as a
- 16 school counselor under Subchapter B, Chapter 21.
- 17 (b) A public school, including an open-enrollment charter
- 18 school, that does not have a full-time nurse, school counselor, or
- 19 librarian or the equivalent of a full-time nurse, school counselor,
- 20 or librarian assigned to be present at the school for more than 30
- 21 consecutive instructional days during the same school year shall
- 22 provide written notice of the absence to the parent of or other
- 23 person standing in parental relation to each student enrolled in
- 24 the school.

- 1 (c) A school has the equivalent of a full-time nurse under
- 2 Subsection (b) if the school has two or more nurses assigned to the
- 3 school and all regular student instructional hours at the campus
- 4 during the regular school day are covered by the assignment of at
- 5 least one nurse.
- 6 (d) A school has the equivalent of a full-time school
- 7 counselor under Subsection (b) if the school has two or more school
- 8 counselors assigned to the school and all regular student
- 9 instructional hours at the campus during the regular school day are
- 10 covered by the assignment of at least one school counselor.
- 11 (e) A school has the equivalent of a full-time librarian
- 12 under Subsection (b) if the school has two or more librarians
- 13 assigned to the school and all regular student instructional hours
- 14 at the campus during the regular school day are covered by the
- 15 <u>assignment of at least one librarian.</u>
- 16 (f) The principal of the school shall provide the notice
- 17 required by Subsection (b) not later than the 30th instructional
- 18 day after the first day the school does not have a full-time nurse,
- 19 school counselor, or librarian assigned to be present at the
- 20 school.
- 21 (g) The school shall:
- 22 (1) make a good faith effort to ensure that the notice
- 23 required by this section is provided in a bilingual form to any
- 24 parent or other person standing in parental relation whose primary
- 25 language is not English; and
- 26 (2) retain a copy of any notice provided under this
- 27 section.

- 1 (h) A school may satisfy the notice requirement under
- 2 Subsection (f) by posting the notice on the school's Internet
- 3 website. Notice posted under this subsection must be accessible
- 4 from the home page of the Internet website by use of not more than
- 5 three links.
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 7 school year.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 9 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 10 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 11 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 12 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
