A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to providing free full-day prekindergarten for certain 3 children. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Sections 29.153(a-1), (b), (c), and (f), Education Code, are amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a-1) A district shall offer prekindergarten classes to any child [if the district identifies 15 or more children] who is [are 8 eligible under Subsection (b) and are] at least four years of age. 9 A school district may offer prekindergarten classes if the district 10 11 identifies 15 or more [eligible] children who are eligible under 12 Subsection (b)(1) [at least three years of age]. A district may not charge tuition for a prekindergarten class offered under this 13 14 section. A child is eligible for enrollment in a prekindergarten 15 (b) 16 class under this section if the child is: (1) at least three years of age and: 17 18 (A) [(1)] is unable to speak and comprehend the English language; 19 (B) [(2)] is educationally disadvantaged; 20 21 (C) [(3)] is a homeless child, as defined by 42 U.S.C. Section 11434a, regardless of the residence of the child, of 22 23 either parent of the child, or of the child's guardian or other person having lawful control of the child; 24

1 (D) [(4)] is the child of an active duty member 2 of the armed forces of the United States, including the state 3 military forces or a reserve component of the armed forces, who is 4 ordered to active duty by proper authority;

5 <u>(E)</u> [(5)] is the child of a member of the armed 6 forces of the United States, including the state military forces or 7 a reserve component of the armed forces, who was injured or killed 8 while serving on active duty; or

9 <u>(F)</u> [(6)] is or ever has been in the 10 conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services 11 following an adversary hearing held as provided by Section 262.201, 12 Family Code<u>; or</u>

(2) at least four years of age.

14 (c) A prekindergarten class under this section shall be 15 operated on a <u>full-day</u> [half-day] basis. A district is not required 16 to provide transportation for a prekindergarten class, but 17 transportation, if provided, is included for funding purposes as 18 part of the regular transportation system.

(f) 19 А child who is eligible for enrollment in а prekindergarten class under Subsection (b)(1)(D) or (E) [(b)(4) or 20 (5)] remains eligible for enrollment if the child's parent leaves 21 the armed forces, or is no longer on active duty, after the child 22 23 begins a prekindergarten class.

24 SECTION 2. Section 29.1531(a), Education Code, is amended 25 to read as follows:

Section 29.1532(c), Education Code, is amended to read as follows: A school district that offers prekindergarten classes, (C) including a high quality prekindergarten program class under Subchapter E-1, shall include the following information in the district's Public Education Information Management System (PEIMS) report: (1)demographic information, as determined by the on students enrolled in district and campus commissioner, prekindergarten classes, including the number of students who are eligible for classes under Section 29.153(b)(1) or (f) [29.153]; numbers of half-day (2) the and full-day prekindergarten classes offered by the district and campus; (3) the sources of funding for the prekindergarten classes; (4) the class size and ratio of instructional staff to students for each prekindergarten program class offered by the district and campus; if the district elects to administer an assessment (5) instrument to students enrolled in district and campus prekindergarten program classes, a description and the results of each type of assessment instrument; and (6) curricula used in the district's prekindergarten

2 SECTION 4. Section 29.166(a), Education Code, is amended to 3 read as follows:

4 (a) A school district is eligible for <u>full-day</u> [half-day]
5 funding under the Foundation School Program for each student who
6 satisfies eligibility requirements under Section 29.153(b) and who
7 is enrolled in a program class.

8 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 9 school year.

10 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
