1-19 relating to access to criminal history record information by the
 1-20 adjutant general.

1-21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-22 SECTION 1. Section 411.121(c), Government Code, is
 1-23 repealed.

1-24 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
 1-25 to a request by the adjutant general to obtain criminal history
 1-26 record information on or after the effective date of this Act. A
 1-27 request for criminal history record information before the
 1-28 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
 1-29 date the information was requested, and the former law is continued
 1-30 in effect for that purpose.

1-31 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
