## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to nonemergency medical transportation, shipping
- 3 logistics, and coordination services for state agencies.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 2172.007, Government
- 6 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2172.007. NONEMERGENCY MEDICAL TRANSPORTATION,
- 8 SHIPPING LOGISTICS, AND COORDINATION SERVICES.
- 9 SECTION 2. Section 2172.007, Government Code, is amended by
- 10 amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d) and adding Subsections
- 11 (f), (g), and (h) to read as follows:
- 12 (a) The comptroller  $\underline{shall}$  [ $\underline{may}$ ] contract with a vendor to
- 13 oversee <u>nonemergency medical transportation</u>, shipping logistics,
- 14 and coordination services for all state agencies and shall pay the
- 15 contract from the anticipated cost savings realized under the
- 16 contract. The vendor shall arrange the transportation or shipment
- 17 of goods, parcels, and freight using the [shipping] company
- 18 selected by the state agency through competitive bidding that
- 19 provides the best value to the agency [for the shipment].
- 20 (b) A state agency <u>shall</u> [may] arrange all <u>transportation or</u>
- 21 shipments of goods, parcels, and freight under this section.
- (c) The vendor under this section shall maintain a record of
- 23 each nonemergency medical transportation and other shipment
- 24 arranged for a state agency, as applicable, including the cost of

- 1 mileage for the nonemergency medical transportation, the cost of
- 2 the <u>transportation or</u> shipment, the type of goods, parcels, or
- 3 freight shipped, [and] the weight of the goods, parcels, or freight
- 4 shipped, and any software licensing support used to meet the

- 6 (d) In contracting for the oversight of <u>nonemergency</u>
- 7 medical transportation, shipping logistics, and coordination
- 8 services under this section, the comptroller shall [may] provide
- 9 contracting opportunities for vendors that employ veterans or other
- 10 persons with disabilities whose products and services are available
- 11 under Chapter 122, Human Resources Code.
- 12 (f) Purchases of nonemergency medical transportation
- 13 <u>services under Section 2155.143, 2155.144, or 2155.1441 are subject</u>
- 14 to this section.
- 15 (g) Not later than December 1, 2018, the comptroller shall
- 16 evaluate the nonemergency medical transportation, shipping
- 17 logistics, and coordination services under this section for not
- 18 more than a 90-day period to determine:
- 19 <u>(1)</u> the viability of contracting with a vendor to
- 20 oversee these services;
- 21 (2) the economic return on investment from contracting

- 23 (3) route efficiency and reasonableness.
- (h) Subsection (g) and this subsection expire September 1,

- SECTION 3. Section 2172.007, Government Code, as amended by
- 27 this Act, applies only to a contract entered into by the comptroller

- 1 and a vendor to which that section applies on or after the effective
- 2 date of this Act.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
