- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 86.0015, Election Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (g) and (h) to read as follows:
- 7 (g) The county clerk shall provide to a voter who has
- 8 applied for and qualifies to receive ballots to be voted by mail
- 9 under this section, with the ballot for an election held on the
- 10 November uniform election date, an application for a ballot to be
- 11 voted by mail and instructions for submitting the application under
- 12 this subsection. The application:
- (1) must be preprinted so that the voter is required
- 14 only to sign and date the application;
- 15 (2) may be returned with the voter's ballot in the
- 16 carrier envelope;
- 17 (3) applies to each election that occurs before
- 18 December 31 of the next even-numbered year following the November
- 19 <u>election</u>, notwithstanding Subsection (b)(2)(A); and
- 20 (4) must be signed by the applicant, or by a witness as
- 21 provided by Section 84.003.
- 22 (h) The county clerk is not required to provide an
- 23 application for a ballot to be voted by mail as provided by
- 24 Subsection (g) in an odd-numbered year to a voter who has previously

- 1 filed an application that covers elections for the next calendar
- 2 year.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 87.044, Election Code, is amended by
- 4 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 5 (c) The early voting ballot board shall deliver to the early
- 6 voting clerk any early voting applications included as provided by
- 7 Section 86.0015(g) in a carrier envelope with a ballot voted in an
- 8 election held on the November uniform election date regardless of
- 9 whether the ballot is accepted.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
