1 AN ACT 2 relating to general officers within the Texas Military Department. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 437.058, Government Code, is amended by 4 5 amending Subsections (a), (d), (e), and (f) and adding Subsection 6 (d-1) to read as follows: 7 (a) The adjutant general may appoint as general officers one or more [an] assistant deputy adjutants [adjutant] general for 8 army, an assistant deputy adjutant general for air, an assistant 9 [deputy] adjutant general for homeland security, and an assistant 10 11 [deputy] adjutant general for domestic operations [government 12 affairs]. 13 (d) The assistant deputy adjutants [adjutant] general for 14 [the] army shall support the deputy adjutant general for [the] army, represent the command staff at events as needed, and manage 15 the activities assigned by the adjutant general or the deputy 16 adjutant general for [the] army. 17 18 (d-1) The assistant deputy adjutant general for air shall support the deputy adjutant general for air, represent the command 19 20 staff at events as needed, and manage the activities assigned by the 21 adjutant general or the deputy adjutant general for air. 22 The assistant [deputy] adjutant general for homeland (e) 23 security [the Army National Guard or the Air National Guard], as 24 determined by the adjutant general, shall:

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1	(1) coordinate with other state agencies in matters
2	pertaining to homeland security [to ensure state emergency services
3	are provided and organized to support the state operations center];
4	and
5	(2) coordinate homeland security actions taken by the
6	National Guard Bureau in this state.
7	(f) The assistant [deputy] adjutant general for <u>domestic</u>
8	operations [the Army National Guard or the Air National Guard, as
9	determined by the adjutant general, shall:
10	(1) coordinate activities of the Texas military forces
11	with the National Guard Bureau to ensure state emergency services
12	are provided and organized to support the state operations center;
13	and
14	(2) coordinate with other federal, state, and local
15	jurisdictions and officials [funding and coordination with other
16	federal, state, and local jurisdictions and officials in matters
17	relating to the operations of the Texas military forces occurring
18	in the assistant deputy adjutant general's jurisdiction or
19	oversight].
20	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
