- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 2266, Government Code, is repealed.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 112.002, Local Government Code,
- amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows: 7
- (c) A regulation adopted under this section may not be 8
- inconsistent with generally accepted accounting principles as 9
- established by the Governmental Accounting Standards Board. 10
- 11 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act apply to
- 12 financial accounting and reporting by a governmental entity that,
- immediately before the effective date of this Act, was subject to 13
- 14 Chapter 2266, Government Code, as repealed by this Act, beginning
- with the governmental entity's first fiscal year that begins on or 15
- 16 after September 1, 2018.

- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 17
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 18
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 19
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
