1-20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT NO. 1 By: Campbell

1-21 Amend H.B. 1934 (house engrossed version) by adding the
 1-22 following appropriately numbered SECTION to the bill and
 1-23 renumbering subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
 1-24 SECTION _____. The State Board for Educator Certification is
 1-25 required to implement this Act only if the legislature appropriates
 1-26 money specifically for that purpose. If the legislature does not
 1-27 appropriate money specifically for that purpose, the board may, but
 1-28 is not required to, implement this Act using other appropriations
 1-29 available for the purpose.

1-30 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-31 AN ACT

1-32 relating to temporary certification of an educator from outside the
 1-33 state who is the spouse of an active duty military service member.

1-34 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-35 SECTION 1. Section 21.052, Education Code, is amended by
 1-36 adding Subsections (b-1) and (d-1) and amending Subsection (c) to
 1-37 read as follows:

1-38 (b-1) The board shall propose rules to establish procedures
 1-39 to expedite the processing of an application for a certificate
 1-40 under this section submitted by an educator who is the spouse of a
 1-41 person who is serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces
 1-42 of the United States, including rules for providing the appropriate
 1-43 documentation to establish the educator's status as a spouse of a
 1-44 person who is serving on active duty as a member of the armed forces
 1-45 of the United States.

1-46 (c) The board may issue a temporary certificate under this
 1-47 section to an educator who holds a degree required by Subsection
 1-48 (a)(1) and a certificate or other credential required by Subsection
 1-49 (a)(2) but who has not satisfied the requirements prescribed by
 1-50 Subsection (a)(3). Subject to Subsections [~~Subsection~~] (d) and
 1-51 (d-1), the board may specify the term of a temporary certificate
 1-52 issued under this subsection.

1-53 (d-1) A temporary certificate issued under Subsection (c)
 1-54 to an educator who is the spouse of a person who is serving on active
 1-55 duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States may not
 1-56 expire before the third anniversary of the date on which the board
 1-57 completes the review of the educator's credentials and informs the
 1-58 educator of the examination or examinations under Section 21.048 on
 1-59 which the educator must perform satisfactorily to receive a

2-1 standard certificate.

2-2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
