## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to certain registrations for the anatomical gift registry.
3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

4 SECTION 1. Section 502.189(b), Transportation Code, is 5 amended to read as follows:

6 The department shall make available for distribution to (b) each office authorized to issue motor vehicle registrations Donate 7 Life brochures that provide basic donor information in English and 8 9 Spanish and a contact phone number and e-mail address. The department shall ensure that the question provided in Section 10 521.401(c-1) [521.401(c)(1)(B)] and information on the donor 11 12 registry Internet website is included with registration renewal notices. 13

SECTION 2. Sections 521.401(c), (c-1), and (e), Transportation Code, are amended to read as follows:

Donor registry information shall be provided to the 16 (c) department and the Texas Department of Transportation by organ 17 procurement organizations, tissue banks, or eye banks, as those 18 terms are defined in Section 692A.002, Health and Safety Code, or by 19 20 the Glenda Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry operated under Chapter 21 692A, Health and Safety Code. The department, with expert input and support from the nonprofit organization administering the Glenda 22 23 Dawson Donate Life-Texas Registry, shall:

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(1) provide to each applicant for the issuance of an

No. 1938 1 original, renewal, corrected, or duplicate driver's license or personal identification certificate who applies in person, by mail, 2 3 over the Internet, or by other electronic means: 4 (A) if the applicant is younger than 18 years of 5 age: 6 (i) the opportunity to indicate on the 7 person's driver's license or personal identification certificate 8 that the person is willing to make an anatomical gift, in the event of death, in accordance with Section 692A.005, Health and Safety 9 10 Code; and 11 (ii) [<del>(B)</del>] an opportunity for the person to 12 consent to inclusion in the statewide Internet-based registry of 13 organ, tissue, and eye donors and release to procurement organizations in the manner provided by Subsection (c-1); and 14 15 (B) if the applicant is 18 years of age or older: 16 (i) the opportunity to refuse to indicate 17 on the person's driver's license or personal identification certificate that the person is willing to make an anatomical gift, 18 19 in the event of death, in accordance with Section 692A.005, Health 20 and Safety Code; and 21 (ii) an opportunity for the person to 22 refuse to consent to inclusion in the statewide Internet-based registry of organ, tissue, and eye donors and release to 23 procurement organizations in the manner provided by Subsection 24 25 (c-1); and 26 (2) provide a means to distribute donor registry information to interested individuals in each office authorized to 27

1 issue driver's licenses or personal identification certificates. (c-1) The department shall: 2 3 (1)for an applicant younger than 18 years of age: 4 (A) specifically ask each applicant only the 5 question, "Would you like to register as an organ donor?"; and 6 (B) [<del>(2)</del>] if the applicant responds affirmatively 7 to the question asked under Paragraph (A) 8 [Subdivision (1)], provide the person's name, date of birth, driver's license number, most recent address, and other information 9 10 needed for identification purposes at the time of donation to the nonprofit organization contracted to maintain the statewide donor 11 registry under Section 692A.020, Health and Safety Code, for 12 inclusion in the registry; and 13 14 (2) for an applicant who is 18 years of age or older: 15 (A) specifically ask each applicant the question, "Would you like to refuse to join the organ donor 16 17 registry?" and state, "If you answer 'no' to the previous question or do not answer the previous question, you consent to join the 18 19 organ donor registry by performing either of those actions."; and (B) if the applicant does not affirmatively 20 refuse to be included in the registry under Paragraph (A), provide 21 the person's name, date of birth, driver's license number, most 22 recent address, and other information needed for identification 23 24 purposes at the time of donation to the nonprofit organization contracted to maintain the statewide donor registry under Section 25 26 692A.020, Health and Safety Code, for inclusion in the registry. The department shall distribute at all field offices 27 (e)

1 Donate Life brochures that provide basic donation information in 2 English and Spanish and include a contact phone number and e-mail 3 address. The department shall include the question required under 4 Subsection (c-1) [(c)(1)(B)] and information on the donor registry 5 Internet website in renewal notices.

6 SECTION 3. Section 692A.005(a), Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

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(a) A donor may make an anatomical gift:

9 (1) <u>on inclusion in the Glenda Dawson Donate</u> 10 <u>Life-Texas Registry, as demonstrated</u> by [authorizing] a statement 11 or symbol indicating that the donor has made an anatomical gift [<del>to</del> 12 <del>be</del>] imprinted on the donor's driver's license or identification 13 card <u>in the manner described by Section 521.401, Transportation</u> 14 Code;

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(2) in a will;

16 (3) during a terminal illness or injury of the donor, 17 by any form of communication addressed to at least two adults, at 18 least one of whom is a disinterested witness; or

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(4) as provided in Subsection (b).

20 SECTION 4. Section 692A.007(a), Health and Safety Code, is 21 amended to read as follows:

(a) An individual may refuse to make an anatomical gift ofthe individual's body or part by:

24 (1) a record signed by:

25 (A) the individual; or

26 (B) subject to Subsection (b), another27 individual acting at the direction of the individual if the

1 individual is physically unable to sign;

2 (2) the individual's will, whether or not the will is
3 admitted to probate or invalidated after the individual's death;
4 [<del>or</del>]

5 (3) any form of communication made by the individual 6 during the individual's terminal illness or injury addressed to at 7 least two adults, at least one of whom is a disinterested witness<u>;</u> 8 or

9 <u>(4) the individual's application for an original,</u> 10 <u>renewal, corrected, or duplicate driver's license or personal</u> 11 <u>identification certificate, in the manner described by Section</u> 12 <u>521.401, Transportation Code, if the individual is 18 years of age</u> 13 or older.

14 SECTION 5. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 15 a driver's license or personal identification certificate for which an application is submitted on or after the effective date of this 16 17 Act. A driver's license or personal identification certificate for which an application was submitted before the effective date of 18 this Act is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the 19 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 20 that purpose. 21

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SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
