8	Sec. 1003.006. STUDY ON REGISTRATION OF COMMERCIAL MOTOR
9	VEHICLES. (a) The department shall:
10	(1) conduct a study that:
11	(A) identifies and assesses alternative
12	technologies for registering commercial motor vehicles to replace
13	license plates, permits, and other existing documentation and
14	registration methods currently in use in this state; and
15	(B) evaluates the safety and suitability for use
16	on roadways of the technologies identified under Paragraph (A); and
17	(2) submit a report on the results of the study to the
18	governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the house of
19	representatives, and the chair of the standing committee of each
20	house of the legislature with primary jurisdiction over
21	transportation issues not later than December 21, 2018.

- 2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
