Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, 5 is amended by adding Section 302.0033 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 302.0033. OPERATION WELCOME HOME PROGRAM. (a) The 7 commission shall establish and administer the Operation Welcome 8 9 Home program to expedite the entry of veterans and military servicemembers into the workforce through the use of enhanced 10 employment services. In establishing the program, the commission 11 12 shall build partnerships between military transition centers and local workforce development boards to ensure the availability of 13 14 employment services, including services related to: (1) education; 15 16 (2) career technical training; and 17 (3) entrepreneurship. 18 (b) The commission may award grants to state, local, or 19 private entities that perform activities related to the purposes of this section. 20 21 (c) The commission shall administer the program using money previously appropriated to the commission or received from federal 22 23 or other sources. 24 (d) The commission may adopt rules as necessary for the

2 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 3 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 4 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 5 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 6 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
