- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 826.042, Health and Safety Code, is
- 5 amended by adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows:
- 6 (f) At the time an owner submits for quarantine an animal
- 7 described by Subsection (b), the veterinarian or local rabies
- 8 control authority, as applicable, shall:
- 9 (1) provide written notification to the animal's owner
- 10 of the date the animal enters quarantine and the date the animal
- 11 will be released from quarantine;
- 12 (2) obtain and retain with the animal's records a
- 13 <u>written statement signed by the animal's owner and a supervisor</u>
- 14 employed by the veterinarian or local rabies control authority
- 15 acknowledging that the information required by Subdivision (1) has
- 16 been provided to the animal's owner; and
- 17 (3) provide the animal's owner a copy of the signed
- 18 written statement obtained under Subdivision (2).
- 19 <u>(g) A veterinarian or local rabies control authority, as</u>
- 20 applicable, shall identify each animal quarantined under this
- 21 section with a placard or other marking on the animal's kennel that
- 22 indicates the animal is quarantined under this section.
- 23 SECTION 2. Section 826.043, Health and Safety Code, is
- 24 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to

- 2 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the [The]
- 3 veterinarian or local rabies control authority may sell the animal
- 4 and retain the proceeds or keep, grant, or destroy an animal if the
- 5 owner or custodian does not take possession of the animal before the
- 6 fourth day following the final day of the quarantine period.
- 7 (e) A veterinarian or local rabies control authority may not
- 8 destroy an animal following the final day of the quarantine period
- 9 unless the veterinarian or local rabies control authority has:
- 10 (1) notified the animal's owner of the animal's
- 11 scheduled destruction; and
- 12 (2) provided the animal's owner a reasonable
- 13 opportunity to take possession of the animal after providing the
- 14 notice required by Subdivision (1).
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
