## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the quarantine of rabid animals. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Section 826.042, Health and Safety Code, 4 is 5 amended by adding Subsections (f) and (g) to read as follows: 6 (f) At the time an owner submits for quarantine an animal described by Subsection (b), the veterinarian or local rabies 7 control authority, as applicable, shall: 8 9 (1) provide written notification to the animal's owner of the date the animal enters quarantine and the date the animal 10 will be released from quarantine; 11 12 (2) obtain and retain with the animal's records a written statement signed by the animal's owner and a supervisor 13 14 employed by the veterinarian or local rabies control authority acknowledging that the information required by Subdivision (1) has 15 16 been provided to the animal's owner; and (3) provide the animal's owner a copy of the signed 17 written statement obtained under Subdivision (2). 18 (g) A veterinarian or local rabies control authority, as 19 applicable, shall fit each animal quarantined under this section 20 with a yellow collar that is distinct in color from the collars of 21 other animals under the care of the veterinarian or local rabies 22 23 control authority. 24 SECTION 2. Section 826.043, Health and Safety Code, is

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1 amended by amending Subsection (d) and adding Subsection (e) to 2 read as follows:

3 (d) Except as provided by Subsection (e), the [The] 4 veterinarian or local rabies control authority may sell the animal 5 and retain the proceeds or keep, grant, or destroy an animal if the 6 owner or custodian does not take possession of the animal before the 7 fourth day following the final day of the guarantine period.

8 (e) A veterinarian or local rabies control authority may not 9 destroy an animal following the final day of the quarantine period 10 unless the veterinarian or local rabies control authority has:

11 (1) notified the animal's owner of the animal's 12 scheduled destruction; and

13 (2) provided the animal's owner a reasonable 14 opportunity to take possession of the animal after providing the 15 notice required by Subdivision (1).

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
