H.B. No. 2009

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to an exemption for certain law enforcement and military
3 personnel from the requirement to complete a hunter education
4 program.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 62.014, Parks and Wildlife Code, is
7 amended by amending Subsection (n) to read as follows:

8 (n) The following persons are exempt from any requirement to
9 complete ~~[the live firing portion of]~~ a hunter education course
10 under this section:

11 (1) an honorably discharged veteran of the United
12 States armed forces~~[,]~~ or

13 ~~[(2)]~~ a person who is on active duty as a member of the
14 United States armed ~~[military]~~ forces;

15 (2) a person who is on active duty or has previously
16 served as a member of the Texas Army National Guard, the Texas Air
17 National Guard, or the Texas State Guard; or

18 (3) a person who is serving as a peace officer
19 described by Subdivision (1), (2), (3), or (4), Article 2.12, Code
20 of Criminal Procedure~~[, the Texas Army National Guard, the Texas~~
21 ~~Air National Guard, or the Texas State Guard]~~.

22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
