H.B. No. 2010

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

1
2 relating to providing workplace safety training information for use
3 in the public school curriculum.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
6 amended by adding Section 29.923 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 29.923. WORKPLACE SAFETY TRAINING INFORMATION. (a)
8 The agency shall collect and make available to a school district on
9 request information regarding workplace safety training that may be
10 included as part of the district's curriculum.

11 (b) A school district may develop a workplace safety program
12 that provides educators access to the information described by
13 Subsection (a) and encourages educators to include the workplace
14 safety training information in the curriculum of appropriate
15 courses provided to students enrolled in grades 7 through 12.

16 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
17 school year.

18 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
22 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
