| 11 | Sec. 113.002. APPLICABILITY OF CHAPTER. This chapter does          |
| 12 | not apply to the publication of an image:                          |
| 13 | (1) by a bona fide member of the news media when acting            |
| 14 | in that capacity;  |
| 15 | (2) by law enforcement personnel in the performance of             |
| 16 | their duties; or   |
| 17 | (3) into the public domain by an individual who                    |
| 18 | appears in the image.  |
| 19 | Sec. 113.003. PUBLICATION OF UNAUTHORIZED IMAGE                    |
| 20 | PROHIBITED. A person may not publish an unauthorized image on the  |
| 21 | Internet.  |
| 22 | Sec. 113.004. REQUEST FOR REMOVAL OF UNAUTHORIZED IMAGE. A         |
| 23 | business entity that owns or operates an Internet website and      |
| 24 | receives a request from an individual who is depicted in an        |

unauthorized image for removal of the unauthorized image from the 1 website shall remove the image not more than 48 hours after the 2 3 business entity receives the request. 4 Sec. 113.005. CIVIL PENALTY; INJUNCTION. (a) A business 5 entity that violates Section 113.004 is liable to this state for a 6 civil penalty in an amount not to exceed \$200. 7 (b) The attorney general or an appropriate local 8 prosecuting attorney may bring an action to collect a civil penalty 9 imposed under this section. 10 (c) If the attorney general brings an action under Subsection (b) and prevails, the civil penalty shall be deposited 11 12 in the state treasury to the credit of the general revenue fund. If a local prosecuting attorney brings the action and prevails, the 13 civil penalty shall be deposited in the general fund of the 14 15 appropriate county. 16 (d) The attorney general may bring an action in the name of 17 this state to restrain or enjoin a violation or threatened violation of this chapter. 18 SECTION 2. Chapter 113, Business & Commerce Code, as added 19 by this Act, applies to any publication of an image that occurs on 20 or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether the 21 image was initially published before that date. 22 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
