7 SECTION 2. An offense under Section 17.22, Business & Commerce Code, may not be prosecuted after the effective date of 8 this Act. If on the effective date of this Act a criminal action is 9 pending for an offense under Section 17.22, Business & Commerce 10 11 Code, the action is dismissed on that date. However, a final 12 conviction for an offense under Section 17.22, Business & Commerce Code, that exists on the effective date of this Act is unaffected by 13 14 this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
