- amended to read as follows: 7
- (a) All information submitted to the commission under this 8
- subchapter, including a copy of that information retained by the 9
- submitting law enforcement agency, is confidential and is not 10
- 11 subject to disclosure under Chapter 552, Government Code, unless
- 12 the person resigned or was terminated due to substantiated
- 13 incidents of excessive force or violations of the law other than
- 14 traffic offenses.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15
- a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16
- 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
