## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to fines collected by a county or municipality from the 3 enforcement of commercial motor vehicle safety standards. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 644.102, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Subsections (f-1) and (f-2) to read as follows: 6 7 (f-1) A municipality or county that retains a fine from the enforcement of this chapter shall annually file with the 8 comptroller a report that details the amount of fines retained from 9 the enforcement of this chapter and the actual expenses claimed by 10

- 11 the municipality or county for the enforcement of this chapter
- 12 during the previous fiscal year. A municipality or county that
- 13 fails to file a report as required by this subsection shall send to
- 14 the comptroller for deposit to the credit of the Texas Department of
- 15 Transportation an amount equal to the amount retained by the
- 16 municipality or county in the fiscal year the report would cover.
- 17 <u>(f-2) The comptroller shall adopt rules as necessary to</u>
- 18 <u>implement and enforce Subsection (f-1).</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
