A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2 relating to the eligibility and requirements for the issuance and

- 3 renewal of a license in massage therapy.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 455.1525, Occupations Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 455.1525. CRIMINAL <u>HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION</u>
- 8 REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSE ISSUANCE [BACKGROUND CHECKS]. (a) The
- 9 department shall require that an applicant for a license submit a
- 10 complete and legible set of fingerprints, on a form prescribed by
- 11 the department, to the department or to the Department of Public
- 12 Safety for the purpose of obtaining criminal history record
- 13 <u>information from the Department of Public Safety and the Federal</u>
- 14 Bureau of Investigation [On receipt of an application for a license
- 15 under this chapter, the department shall conduct a criminal
- 16 background check on the applicant].
- 17 (b) The department may not issue a license to a person who
- 18 does not comply with the requirement of Subsection (a).
- 19 <u>(c) The department shall conduct a criminal history record</u>
- 20 information check of each applicant for a license using
- 21 information:
- 22 (1) provided by the individual under this section; and
- 23 (2) made available to the department by the Department
- 24 of Public Safety, the Federal Bureau of Investigation, and any

- 1 other criminal justice agency under Chapter 411, Government Code.
- 2 (d) The department may:
- 3 (1) enter into an agreement with the Department of
- 4 Public Safety to administer a criminal history record information
- 5 check required under this section; and
- 6 (2) authorize the Department of Public Safety to
- 7 collect from each applicant the costs incurred by the Department of
- 8 Public Safety in conducting the criminal history record information
- 9 check [An applicant is not eligible for a license under this chapter
- 10 if the applicant, in the five years preceding the date of the
- 11 application, has been finally convicted of a misdemeanor involving
- 12 moral turpitude or a felony].
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 455, Occupations Code, is
- 14 amended by adding Section 455.1605 to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 455.1605. CRIMINAL HISTORY RECORD INFORMATION
- 16 REQUIREMENT FOR LICENSE RENEWAL. (a) An applicant renewing a
- 17 license issued under this chapter shall submit a complete and
- 18 legible set of fingerprints for purposes of performing a criminal
- 19 history record information check of the applicant as provided by
- 20 Section 455.1525.
- 21 (b) The department may not renew the license of a person who
- 22 does not comply with the requirement of Subsection (a).
- (c) A license holder is not required to submit fingerprints
- 24 under this section for the renewal of the license if the license
- 25 holder has previously submitted fingerprints under:
- 26 (1) Section 455.1525 for the initial issuance of the
- 27 license; or

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- 1 (2) this section as part of a prior license renewal.
- 2 (d) This section expires August 1, 2023.
- 3 SECTION 3. Not later than April 1, 2018, the Texas
- 4 Commission of Licensing and Regulation shall adopt rules as
- 5 necessary to implement Section 455.1525, Occupations Code, as
- 6 amended by this Act, and Section 455.1605, Occupations Code, as
- 7 added by this Act.
- 8 SECTION 4. Section 455.1525, Occupations Code, as amended
- 9 by this Act, and Section 455.1605, Occupations Code, as added by
- 10 this Act, apply only to an application for the issuance or renewal
- 11 of a license submitted on or after August 1, 2018. An application
- 12 submitted before that date is governed by the law in effect on the
- 13 date the application was submitted, and the former law is continued
- 14 in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
