7	(a) The newspaper in which a notice is published must:
8	(1) devote not less than 25 percent of its total column
9	lineage to general interest items;
10	(2) be published at least once each week; and
11	(3) [be entered as second-class postal matter in the
12	<pre>county where published; and</pre>
13	[(4)] have been published regularly and continuously
14	for at least 12 months before the governmental entity or
15	representative publishes notice.
16	SECTION 2. Section 2051.049, Government Code, is amended to
17	read as follows:
18	Sec. 2051.049. SELECTION OF NEWSPAPER. (a) The
19	governmental entity or representative required to publish a notice
20	in a newspaper shall select, in accordance with this subchapter,
21	one or more newspapers to publish the notice.
22	(b) To encourage the development of minority-owned
23	businesses in this state, a governmental entity or representative
24	that publishes a notice in a newspaper under Section 2051.044 shall

1 consider selecting a newspaper that is a minority-owned business 2 if: 3 (1) a substantial percentage of the individuals residing in the area where the notice is to be published are members 4 5 of one or more minority groups; and 6 (2) a newspaper in the area where the notice is to be published: 7 8 (A) is a minority-owned business; and 9 (B) is widely circulated in that area. (c) In this section, "minority-owned business" and 10 "minority group" have the meanings assigned by Section 161.131(c), 11 12 Natural Resources Code. SECTION 3. Section 2051.044(a), Government Code, as amended 13 14 by this Act, and Section 2051.049(b), Government Code, as added by this Act, apply only to a publication of notice first published on 15 or after the effective date of this Act. A publication of notice 16 published before the effective date of this Act is governed by the 17 law in effect at the time of the publication, and the former law is 18 continued in effect for that purpose. 19 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
