8	[(1) "Administrator" means the person responsible for
9	the administration of a legal service contract. The term includes a
10	person responsible for any filing required by this chapter.
11	[(2) "Company" means a person who:
12	[(A) is contractually obligated to a legal
13	service contract holder under the terms of a legal service
14	contract;
15	[(B) enters into a contract with a contracting
16	attorney to provide or obtain covered legal services for a legal
17	service contract holder; and
18	(C) operates as a for-profit legal service
19	contract company.
20	[(3) "Contracting attorney" means an attorney who has
21	entered into a contract with a company to provide or obtain covered
22	legal services for a legal service contract holder.
23	[(4) "Department" means the Texas Department of
24	Licensing and Regulation.
