- 5 SECTION 1. Section 408.183(b-1), Labor Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), an eligible spouse
- 8 who remarried is eligible for death benefits for life if the
- 9 employee was a first responder, as defined by Section 504.055, who
- 10 suffered death in the course and scope of employment or while
- 11 providing services as a volunteer. This subsection applies
- 12 regardless of the date on which the death of the first responder
- 13 <u>occurred.</u>
- SECTION 2. Section 2, Chapter 1018 (H.B. 1094), Acts of the
- 15 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, is repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 17 408.183, Labor Code, applies only to an eligible spouse who
- 18 remarries on or after the effective date of this Act. An eligible
- 19 spouse who remarried before that date is governed by the law as it
- 20 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
- 21 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
