- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 408.183(b-1), Labor Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b-1) Notwithstanding Subsection (b), an eligible spouse
- 8 who remarried is eligible for death benefits for life if the
- 9 employee was a first responder, as defined by Section 504.055, who
- 10 suffered death in the course and scope of employment or while
- 11 providing services as a volunteer. This subsection applies
- 12 regardless of the date on which the death of the first responder
- 13 occurred or the spouse remarried.
- SECTION 2. Section 2, Chapter 1018 (H.B. 1094), Acts of the
- 15 84th Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, is repealed.
- 16 SECTION 3. A person who becomes eligible to receive
- 17 benefits as a result of the change in law made by this Act is
- 18 entitled only to benefits that accrue on or after the effective date
- 19 of this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
