If the department determines the person is an active duty member of the United States armed 13 14 forces or the spouse of a member on active duty, the department shall notify the United States Department of Defense Family 15 16 Advocacy Program at the closest active duty military installation of the investigation. 17 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act to Section 18 261.301, Family Code, apply only to a report of abuse or neglect 19 made on or after the effective date of this Act. A report made 20 21 before that date is governed by the law in effect on the date the report was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that 22
