2	relating to a study conducted by the Texas Education Agency
3	regarding the impact of the statewide assessment program on
4	students in special education programs.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 39, Education Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 39.02302 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 39.02302. STUDY OF IMPACT OF STATEWIDE ASSESSMENT
9	PROGRAM ON STUDENTS IN SPECIAL EDUCATION PROGRAMS. (a) The agency
10	shall conduct a study of the impact of the statewide assessment
11	program on students in a special education program under Subchapter
12	A, Chapter 29.
13	(b) In conducting the study, the agency shall address:
14	(1) whether the agency has determined that the
15	administration of alternate assessment instruments to students in a
16	special education program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, as
17	provided by Section 39.023(b) complies with the Every Student
18	Succeeds Act (20 U.S.C. Section 6301 et seq.); and
19	(2) whether administering state-required assessment
20	instruments, other than assessment instruments developed or
21	adopted under Section 39.023(b), to students in a special education
22	program under Subchapter A, Chapter 29, will:
23	(A) provide an accurate assessment of the
24	academic achievement of the students;

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1	(B) result in the administration of assessment
2	instruments that are inappropriate for the educational capacity of
3	the students; and
4	(C) result in an increase of grade-level
5	regression for the students.
6	(c) In conducting the study the agency shall identify
7	specific recommendations to improve the impact of the statewide
8	assessment program on students in a special education program under
9	Subchapter A, Chapter 29, including recommendations for areas for
10	improvement in:
11	(1) any reforms or changes with respect to contracting
12	with assessment instrument vendors;
13	(2) any changes to rules adopted by the State Board of
14	Education or the commissioner relating to the development,
15	adoption, or administration of assessment instruments; and
16	(3) any statutory changes to this code relating to the
17	development, adoption, or administration of assessment
18	instruments.
19	(d) Not later than October 1, 2018, the agency shall submit
20	a report to each member of the legislature containing the agency's
21	determinations and recommendations under this section.
22	(e) This section expires January 1, 2019.
23	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
25	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
26	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

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
