- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1953, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1953.053 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1953.053. RATE CONSEQUENCE PROHIBITED. An insurer
- 8 described by Section 1952.001 or a county mutual insurance company
- 9 may not assign a rate consequence on, or otherwise cause a premium
- 10 increase for, an insured's personal automobile insurance policy
- 11 based on the insured's involvement in an accident:
- 12 (1) arising from the insured's operation, maintenance,
- 13 or use of a motor vehicle covered by the insured's personal
- 14 automobile insurance policy; and
- 15 (2) for which the insured is determined to not be at
- 16 fault.

- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 18 to a personal automobile insurance policy delivered, issued for
- 19 delivery, or renewed on or after January 1, 2018. A personal
- 20 automobile insurance policy delivered, issued for delivery, or
- 21 renewed before January 1, 2018, is governed by the law in effect
- 22 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 23 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
