## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the creation by the Texas Higher Education Coordinating
- 3 Board of a repository of student transcripts for certain private
- 4 postsecondary educational institutions; authorizing fees.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 61.315, Education Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 61.315. AGENTS AND RECORDS; TRANSCRIPT REPOSITORY FOR
- 9 CERTAIN CLOSED INSTITUTIONS AND RELATED FEES. (a) The authorized
- 10 or certified institutions may be required to furnish a list of their
- 11 agents to the board, and to maintain records of students enrolled,
- 12 credits awarded, and degrees awarded in a manner specified by the
- 13 board.
- 14 (b) The board shall maintain a repository for student
- 15 transcripts from closed institutions that were issued a certificate
- of authority under Section 61.306. The board may charge a fee to
- 17 students requesting transcript copies maintained in the
- 18 repository, not to exceed the cost of retrieving, reproducing, and
- 19 sending the transcript copies. A closed or closing institution
- 20 that was issued a certificate of authority under Section 61.306
- 21 shall provide its student transcript records to the board in the
- 22 format specified by the board for inclusion in the repository.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
