## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the elevation of high-speed rail tracks in certain
3	counties.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 112, Transportation Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 112.104 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 112.104. ELEVATED HIGH-SPEED RAIL TRACKS IN CERTAIN
8	COUNTIES. (a) In this section, "high-speed rail" means intercity
9	passenger rail reasonably expected to reach speeds of at least 120
10	miles per hour.
11	(b) High-speed rail tracks located in a county with a
12	population of more than one million or a county adjacent to a county
13	with a population of more than one million must be elevated on
14	pylons to 40 feet or more above the ground.
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
