A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the date of the election for trustees of an independent
3	school district.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 11.0581(a), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(a) An election for trustees of an independent school
8	district shall be held on the same date as[\div
9	(1) the election for the members of the governing body
10	of a municipality located in the school district;
11	$\left[\frac{(2)}{2}\right]$ the general election for state and county
12	officers[+
13	(3) the election for the members of the governing body
14	of a hospital district, if the school district:
15	[(A) is wholly or partly located in a county with
16	a population of less than 40,000 that is adjacent to a county with a
17	population of more than three million; and
18	[(B) held its election for trustees jointly with
19	the election for the members of the governing body of the hospital
20	district before May 2007; or
21	[(4) the election for the members of the governing
22	board of a public junior college district in which the school
23	district is wholly or partly located].

SECTION 2. Sections 11.059(a) and (e), Education Code, are

- 1 amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) A trustee of an independent school district serves a
- 3 term of [three or] four years.
- 4 (e) Not later than December 31, 2017 $[\frac{2011}{2011}]$, the board of
- 5 trustees may adopt a resolution changing the length of the terms of
- 6 its trustees. The resolution must provide for staggered terms of
- 7 [either three or] four years and specify the manner in which the
- 8 transition from the length of the former term to the modified term
- 9 is made. The transition must begin with the first regular election
- 10 for trustees that occurs after January 1, 2018 [2012], and a trustee
- 11 who serves on that date shall serve the remainder of that
- 12 term. This subsection expires January 1, 2023 [2017].
- SECTION 3. Section 11.065(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 14 read as follows:
- 15 (a) Sections 11.052(g) and (h) and <u>Sections</u> [Sections]
- 16 11.059(a) [and (b)] do not apply to the board of trustees of a
- 17 school district if:
- 18 (1) the district's central administrative office is
- 19 located in a county with a population of more than two million; and
- 20 (2) the district's student enrollment is more than
- 21 125,000 and less than 200,000.
- SECTION 4. Section 11.059(b), Education Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
