AN ACT

- 2 relating to a limitation on the amount of attorney's fees awarded in
- 3 a case assigned to a special three-judge district court.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 22A, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Section 22A.0055 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 22A.0055. ATTORNEY'S FEES. In a case assigned to a
- 8 special three-judge district court under this chapter and in any
- 9 related case consolidated with the case before the court, the court
- 10 may not award attorney's fees in an amount that exceeds \$250,000.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 22A.0055, Government Code, as added by
- 12 this Act, applies only to a case assigned to a special three-judge
- 13 district court on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
