- 6 SECTION 1. Section 623.364, Transportation Code, is amended
- 7 to read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 623.364. PERMIT FEES. (a) The authority may collect a
- 9 fee for permits issued under this subchapter. Beginning September
- 10 1, 2017 [2013], the maximum amount of the fee may not exceed \$200
- 11 [\$80] per trip. On September 1 of each subsequent year, the
- 12 authority may adjust the maximum fee amount as necessary to reflect
- 13 the percentage change during the preceding year in the Consumer
- 14 Price Index for All Urban Consumers (CPI-U), U.S. City Average,
- 15 published monthly by the United States Bureau of Labor Statistics
- 16 or its successor in function.
- 17 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), fees [Fees]
- 18 collected under Subsection (a) shall be used only for the
- 19 construction and maintenance of the roads described by or
- 20 designated under Section 623.363 and for the authority's
- 21 administrative costs, which may not exceed 10 [15] percent of the
- 22 fees collected. The authority shall make payments to the Texas
- 23 Department of Transportation to provide funds for the maintenance

- 2 amount not to exceed five percent of the fees collected to leverage
- 3 <u>funding from other sources to:</u>
- 4 (1) construct a bridge on Farm-to-Market Road 1015 in
- 5 Hidalgo County between Military Highway and Mile 5 Road North;
- 6 (2) improve the roads described by Section 623.363
- 7 that are in Weslaco or Progreso;
- 8 (3) improve Mile 5 Road North in Hidalgo County; and
- 9 (4) support the construction of roads proposed by the
- 10 City of Donna connecting a proposed commercial import lot near the
- 11 Donna-Rio Bravo International Bridge to Farm-to-Market Road 493 and
- 12 <u>Military Highway</u>.
