A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to coverage for certain services related to maternal
- 3 depression under the Medicaid and child health plan programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 62, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 62.1511 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 62.1511. COVERAGE FOR MATERNAL DEPRESSION SCREENING.
- 8 (a) In this section, "maternal depression" means depression of any
- 9 <u>severity with postpartum onset.</u>
- 10 (b) The covered services under the child health plan must
- 11 include a maternal depression screening for an enrollee's mother,
- 12 regardless of whether the mother is also an enrollee, that is
- 13 performed during a covered well-child visit for the enrollee that
- 14 occurs before the enrollee's first birthday.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 32, Human Resources Code,
- 16 is amended by adding Section 32.0561 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 32.0561. MATERNAL DEPRESSION SCREENING. (a) In this
- 18 <u>section</u>, "maternal depression" means depression of any severity
- 19 with postpartum onset.
- 20 (b) The commission shall provide medical assistance
- 21 reimbursement for a maternal depression screening for a recipient's
- 22 mother, regardless of whether the mother is also a recipient, that
- 23 is performed during a covered examination for the recipient under
- 24 the early and periodic screening, diagnosis, and treatment program

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- 1 that occurs before the recipient's first birthday.
- 2 SECTION 3. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 3 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 4 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 5 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 6 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 7 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 8 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
