- 6 SECTION 1. Section 683.015(a), Transportation Code, is
- 7 amended to read as follows:
- 8 (a) A law enforcement agency is entitled to reimbursement
- 9 from the proceeds of the sale of an abandoned motor vehicle,
- 10 aircraft, watercraft, or outboard motor for:
- 11 (1) the cost of the auction;
- 12 (2) towing, preservation, and storage fees resulting
- 13 from the taking into custody; [and]
- 14 (3) the cost of notice or publication as required by
- 15 Section 683.012; and
- 16 (4) any compensation made by the agency under
- 17 Subsection (f) to property owners whose property was damaged as a
- 18 result of a pursuit involving the motor vehicle.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 683.015(a), Transportation Code, as
- 20 amended by this Act, applies only to proceeds of a sale of an
- 21 abandoned motor vehicle that takes place on or after the effective
- 22 date of this Act. Proceeds of a sale of an abandoned motor vehicle
- 23 that takes place before the effective date of this Act are governed
- 24 by the law in effect on the date of the sale, and the former law is

- 2 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
