Section 141.031(a), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (a) A candidate's application for a place on the ballot that is required by this code must: 8 9 (1) be in writing; be signed and sworn to by the candidate and 10 (2) 11 indicate the date that the candidate swears to the application; 12 (3) be timely filed with the appropriate authority; 13 and (4) include: 14 (A) the candidate's name; 15 16 (B) the candidate's occupation; 17 the office sought, including any place number (C) or other distinguishing number; 18 (D) an indication of whether the office sought is 19 20 to be filled for a full or unexpired term if the office sought and 21 another office to be voted on have the same title but do not have place numbers or other distinguishing numbers; 22 23 (E) a statement that the candidate is a United 24 States citizen;

No. 2327 1 (F) a statement that the candidate has not been determined by a final judgment of a court exercising probate 2 3 jurisdiction to be: 4 (i) totally mentally incapacitated; or (ii) partially 5 mentally incapacitated 6 without the right to vote; 7 a statement that the candidate has not been (G) 8 finally convicted of a felony from which the candidate has not been pardoned or otherwise released from the resulting disabilities; 9 (H) the candidate's date of birth; 10 (I) the candidate's residence address or, if the 11 residence has no address, the address at which the candidate 12 receives mail and a concise description of the location of the 13 14 candidate's residence; 15 (J) the candidate's length of continuous residence in the state and in the territory from which the office 16 17 sought is elected as of the date the candidate swears to the application; 18 (K) the statement: "I, 19 of \_\_\_\_\_ County, Texas, being a candidate for the office of 20 \_\_\_\_\_, swear that I will support and defend the constitution 21 and laws of the United States and of the State of Texas"; 22 (L) a statement that the candidate is aware of 23 24 the nepotism law, Chapter 573, Government Code; and 25 (M) a public mailing address at which the 26 candidate receives correspondence relating to the candidate's campaign, if available, and an [any available] electronic mail 27

address at which the candidate receives correspondence relating to
the candidate's campaign, if available.

3 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section 4 141.031(a), Election Code, applies to an application for a place on 5 the ballot made on or after the effective date of this Act. An 6 application for a place on the ballot made before the effective date 7 of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the 8 application is made, and the former law is continued in effect for 9 that purpose.
