## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to exempting certain customers from certain demand charges
- 3 by transmission and distribution utilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 36.009, Utilities Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 36.009. BILLING DEMAND FOR CERTAIN UTILITY CUSTOMERS.
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, the
- 9 commission by rule shall require a transmission and distribution
- 10 utility to:
- 11 (1) waive the application of demand ratchet provisions
- 12 for each nonresidential secondary service customer that has a
- 13 maximum load factor equal to or below a factor set by commission
- 14 rule;
- 15 (2) implement procedures to verify annually whether
- 16 each nonresidential secondary service customer has a maximum load
- 17 factor that qualifies the customer for the waiver described by
- 18 Subdivision (1);
- 19 (3) specify in the utility's tariff whether the
- 20 utility's nonresidential secondary service customers that qualify
- 21 for the waiver described by Subdivision (1) are to be billed for
- 22 distribution service charges on the basis of:
- 23 (A) kilowatts;
- 24 (B) kilowatt-hours; or

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- 1 (C) kilovolt-amperes; and
- 2 (4) modify the utility's tariff in the utility's next
- 3 base rate case to implement the waiver described by Subdivision (1)
- 4 and make the specification required by Subdivision (3).
- 5 (b) For each utility that has not initiated a base rate case
- 6 between May 28, 2011, and September 1, 2017, the commission shall
- 7 initiate before January 1, 2018, a proceeding to modify the
- 8 utility's tariff to implement the waiver described by Subsection
- 9 (a)(1) and make the specification required by Subsection (a)(3).
- 10 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 11 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 12 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 13 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 14 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
